**Precautionary Boil Water Notice for Cave Rock and Skyland Water System**

**Minden, NV**– A precautionary boil water notice has been issued for the Cave Rock Water and Skyland System in Douglas County due to a computer error at the Cave Rock Water Treatment Plant. Because of this, we are required to hang precautionary boil water notices at each customer until we recover the data from the error or take (2) consecutive bacteriological samples, back to back, 24 hours apart. We are moving forward with efforts to recover the data and to collect samples for testing.

We are in the process of taking consecutive water samples. Once this process is complete and samples are clean, we can rescind the boil water notices.

**Additional info about our treatment:**

We have a microfiltration plant for treatment and we maintained consistent normal chlorine residual throughout the period when the error occurred. The boil water notice is only precautionary at this time, but we are taking the proper steps to ensure the safety of our residents.
