Minden, NV– Douglas County has selected Tammy James to fill the position of Chief Technology Officer and lead the Technology Services Department. Ms. James replaces the former Chief Technology Officer who resigned in April 2018.

Ms. James has been responsible for planning, organizing and directing all elements of the County’s technology services functions which includes Information Technology, Geographic Information Systems (GIS), Public Safety Radio and Telecommunications.

“Ms. James has seen and understands the unique challenges facing Technology Services over the years due to her experience working alongside her team since 1997,” said Assistant County Manager, Jenifer Davidson. “Ms. James has been a proven leader in the department as well as the entire organization, both in her assigned role and frequently taking on duties of the Chief Technology Officer in the absence of one.”

Ms. James began her official role as Chief Technology Officer on Monday, May 14, 2018.
